This Privacy Policy describes how Nodark Inc, ("we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, and protects the personal information of our donors, supporters, website visitors, and other individuals who interact with us. We are committed to protecting your privacy and handling your personal information with care and transparency.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect personal information from you in various ways, including when you:

- **To Communicate with You:** To send you newsletters, updates about our work, event invitations, and other information that may be of interest to you.
- **To Improve Our Services:** To analyze website usage and donor behavior to improve our website, fundraising campaigns, and overall operations.
- **To Fulfill Your Requests:** To respond to your questions and requests and provide you with the information you have asked for.

- To Maintain Records: To keep accurate records of our donors and supporters.
- To Comply with Legal Obligations: To meet legal and regulatory requirements.

3. Sharing Your Information

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information with other organizations. We may share your information with trusted third-party service providers who assist us in our operations, such as:

- Payment processors to securely process your donations.
- Email marketing services to send our newsletters and other communications.
- Data management services to help us organize and analyze our donor information.

These third-party service providers are required by contract to protect the information they receive from us and to use it only for the purposes for which we provide it.

We may also disclose your information if required by law, such as to comply with a subpoena or other legal process, or if we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, your safety, or the safety of others.

4. Your Choices and Rights

You have the right to control how we use your personal information. You can:

- Review and Update Your Information: You can contact us to request access to the personal information we have about you and to correct any inaccuracies.

6. Children's Privacy

Our website and services are not intended for use by children under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we learn that we have collected information from a child under 13 without parental consent, we will take steps to delete that information as soon as possible.
